- Staffing needs

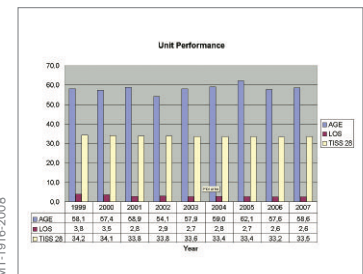

more you know, the better you'll be able to anticipate situations and help prevent problems from arising.

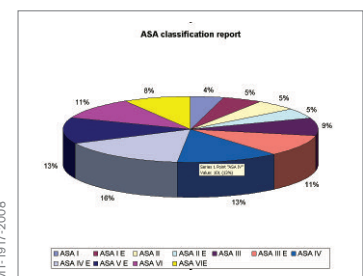
RELY ON INDUSTRY-STANDARD TECHNOLOGY

SQL Server also provides database replication and synchronization to make sure that changes made to Innovian's active clinical database are captured and periodically transmitted to the reporting database. This allows the active database to operate at top efficiency when gathering input from monitoring and therapeutic devices, interfaced hospital information systems, and clinical users.

If you prefer other data extraction and reporting tools – such as Crystal Reports®, Cognos® Impromptu or SPSS – no problem. Innovian's archive database is “flattened” for optimized data mining. Once data is extracted by any of these
